

Market Intelligence

The nuclear sector is experiencing a resurgence of interest, driven by a number of factors. The global energy transition, coupled with the increasing demand for reliable and clean power sources, has reignited discussions around nuclear power. Additionally, advancements in Small Modular Reactor (SMR) technology offer promising solutions for countries seeking to initiate or expand their nuclear programmes.

Recent announcements, such as the UK's third nuclear power project at Wylfa and Canada's 4.8 GW Bruce C nuclear expansion, underscore this renewed global interest. In France, President Emmanuel Macron's ambitious plans to construct six European Pressurized Reactors (EPRs) and additional eight largescale reactors and SMRs demonstrate the country's commitment to nuclear power. However, the challenges associated with large-scale nuclear projects, as evidenced by the delays and cost overruns of the Flamanville 3 unit, highlight the need for innovative approaches and robust project management.

SMRs, with their smaller size, modular design, and enhanced safety features, offer a compelling proposition for countries seeking to enter the nuclear market or expand their existing nuclear fleets. In 2024, the number of countries actively pursuing SMR development has grown to 21, indicating a shift in global acceptance towards this technology. SMRs are particularly well-suited to power-intensive industries such as Al data centres and remote communities that traditionally rely on fossil fuels.

To successfully realize the potential of nuclear power, including SMRs, significant updates in financing mechanisms and supply chain development are crucial. While large-scale nuclear projects have historically attracted substantial investment, the nascent SMR market requires specific support to encourage innovation and accelerate deployment.
